## **Information Update**

- Term 2 begins on February 2, 2018
- Report cards to come home on February 14th, 2018
- There has been some difficulties with the boiler (heating) as well as some issues with the bells. Both have now been fixed.
- Playground boundaries are being redrawn. Students continue to be able to choose whichever yard they'd prefer to play in.
- Please encourage parents of eligible kindergarten students to register ASAP as teacher allotments are based on number of registrations.

• Julie is going to receive training to be able to train parent council about how to post items to the parent council section of the website.

## Staffing and Behaviour Management

- After much advocacy, Devonshire has been alloted one full time Educational Assistant
  (EA) (Laura, 1B, Mme Joan's class). Other supports include other EA (Mary Lee; rotates
  between four students as needed); a social emotional learning teacher (3 weeks), and 1
  iterent EA.
- When Julie is out of the office, there is an "admin designate" who assumes her responsibilities.

## Behaviour Management

- Staff are moving from whole class evacuation to student evacuation.
- Students will continue using "Zones of Regulation" to process emotions and manage behaviour. There are designated "yellow" and "red" zones in the school, and staff are on hand to assist students in transitioning back to "green" zone.
- In order to return to the classroom environment, a student must have 1) a calm body; 2) be able to sit properly and say "I'm calm"; 3) Talk about it (staff will often use Collaborative Problem Solving or CPS); 4) Rebuild; and 5) Go back into routine.
